**Referring Municipality:**

**1. Town of East Lyme:** Proposed revisions to the Town’s Zoning Regulations regarding the number of housing units allowed.

**Finding:** Based on a review of the information submitted, it was determined that State Statutes did not require the referral, since it does not affect land within 500’ of an abutting municipality.

**2. Town of Old Lyme:** Proposed revisions to the Town’s Zoning Regulations regarding the definitions of schools

**Finding:** Based on a review of the information submitted, it was determined that the proposed text amendments would not have any adverse inter-municipal impact.

**3. City of Groton:** Proposed revisions to the City’s Zoning Regulations regarding micro-brewery-distillery-winery facilities.

**Finding:** Based on a review of the information submitted, it was determined that the proposed text amendments would not have any adverse inter-municipal impact.

**4. Town of North Stonington:** Proposed comprehensive revisions to the Town’s Zoning Regulations.
