Referring Municipality:

1. Town of East Lyme: Proposed revisions to the Town’s Zoning Regulations regarding brew pubs in the LI (Light Industrial) Zone.

Finding: Based on a review of the information submitted, it was determined that State Statutes did not require the referral, since it does not affect land within 500’ of an abutting municipality within the Southeastern Connecticut Planning Region.

2. Town of East Hampton: Proposed revisions to the Town’s Zoning Regulations regarding farm brewery and alcoholic beverages.

Finding: Based on a review of the information submitted, it was determined that the proposed text amendments would not have any adverse inter-municipal impact.

3. Town of Ledyard: Proposed revisions to the Town’s Zoning Regulations regarding recreational facilities.

Finding: Based on a review of the information submitted, it was determined that the proposed text amendment would not have any adverse inter-municipal impact.

4. Town of Franklin: Proposed revisions to the Town’s Zoning Map regarding a change from R-120 Residential to C-2 Mixed Commercial and Light Industrial. 1

Finding: Based on a review of the information submitted, it was determined that the proposed map amendment would not have any adverse inter-municipal impact.
