

Connecticut General Statute Referrals.

The following is a summary of CGS referrals for July

Referrals:

Referring Municipality:

1. Noank: Proposed text amendment to Section 2.7b of the Noank Zoning Regulations concerning height limitations for cupolas.

Finding: Based on the review of the information submitted, it was determined that the proposed text amendments would not have any adverse inter-municipal impact.

2. East Haddam: Proposed text amendment to the Town's Zoning Regulations to permit hotels in the Village District.

Finding: Based on the review of the information submitted, it was determined that State statutes did not require the referral, since it does not affect land within 500 feet of a municipal boundary.

3. Stonington: Proposed text amendments to the Town's Zoning Regulations to add Section 7.23 Greenway Development District.

Finding: Based on the review of the information submitted, it was determined that depending on the location of a proposed Greenway Development District in relationship in relationship to the Ledyard and North Stonington town lines, there could be potential inter-municipal impact on residential land uses in these communities.
