Referring Municipality:

1. Town of Scotland: Proposed revisions to the Town's Zoning Regulations regarding farm animals.

Finding: Based on a review of the information submitted, it was determined that the proposed text amendments would not have any adverse inter-municipal impact.

2. Town of Stonington: Proposed revisions to the Town's Zoning Regulations regarding the addition of micro brewery/ brewpubs as a use allowed by special permit in DB-5, LS-5, and M-1 zoning districts.

Finding: Based on a review of the information submitted, it was determined that the proposed text amendments would not have any adverse inter-municipal impact.

3. City of New London: Proposed rezoning of 40 Coit Street to Commercial C-1 from Residential R-3.

Finding: Based on a review of the information submitted, it was determined that State Statutes did not require the referral, since it does not affect land within 500' of an abutting municipality.
