Referring Municipality:

1. Lisbon: Proposed text amendments to Sections 16.1.4 and 6.4.23 of the "Zoning Regulations, Town of Lisbon, Connecticut" requiring referral to be made to the Planning and Zoning Commission for all appeals and variance applications to the Zoning Board of Appeals; and modifying conditions for sale of liquor at restaurants in the IP-1 zoning district.

Finding: Based on the review of the information submitted, it was determined that the proposed text amendments would not have any adverse inter-municipal impact.

2. Voluntown: Proposed text amendments to Sections 2.5, 5A.4, 6.3, 7.8, 8.3, 8.4.1, and 8.10.1 of the "Zoning Regulations of the Town of Voluntown, Connecticut", which clarify buildable area requirements, seek to allow oil storage tanks, seek to prohibit salt storage sheds, and align regulations of uses near water with health codes.

Finding: Based on the review of the information submitted, it was determined that the proposed text amendments would not have any adverse inter-municipal impact.
