LOCAL TRANSPORTATION CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (LOTCIP) SCCOG 2025 SOLICITATION INFORMATION

Grants will be awarded to municipalities on a competitive basis. SCCOG seeks to fund up to \$15 million in transportation capital projects across the region in this funding round.

Project Eligibility

Eligible projects must have an estimated construction cost of between \$300,000 and \$4,000,000. In general, LOTCIP addresses capital improvement projects for regional transportation priorities through state funds. Projects must meet the requirements of the Urban component of the Federal Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) Program. The project identified must be located on a roadway classified as an urban collector or higher on the CTDOT Functional Classification Map database. Maintenance-type work is not eligible for LOTCIP grant improvements. Bridge improvements, multi-use trails, stand-alone sidewalk projects, and road rehabilitation projects are eligible. The 2021 CTDOT LOTCIP Guidelines further define eligibility requirements and establish project criteria. Projects eligible for both TRIP and LOTCIP are encouraged to submit applications for both programs.

Matching Requirements

LOTCIP funds the construction phase of authorized projects and a set-aside for incidentals and contingencies. Other eligible expenditures include property acquisition and eligible utility relocation. The design costs are the responsibility of the municipality and are considered the local match.

Application Components

LOTCIP solicitation process will be conducted in two phases.

Phase I will require municipalities to submit the pre-applications on or before January 17, 2025 for SCCOG staff review. Application materials should be sent to Debra Pierce at dpierce@seccog.org. A completed pre-application contains the following information:

- 1) Cover Page: Application Form
- 2) Section A (1): Type of Proposed Improvement
- 3) Section A (2): Project Purpose and Need Statement outline the identified work and proposed solution
- 4) Section A (3): Scope of Work project description and alternatives considered
- 5) Section A (4): Location Map inclusive of property boundaries and project limits
- 6) Section A (4): Plan Set at a minimum, provide a concept level plan
- 7) Section J (1): Project Cost Estimate a cost range is acceptable in Phase I
- 8) Section O: Request for Subsurface Investigation including details of work needed
- 9) Completed Plan Study Checklist focus on project alignment with goals from previous plans and studies

LOCAL TRANSPORTATION CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (LOTCIP) SCCOG 2025 SOLICITATION INFORMATION

Phase II will submit a complete LOTCIP application as described in the CTDOT LOTCIP Guidelines to the SCCOG. The completed application contains the following information:

- 1) Completed LOTCIP Application (all sections)
- 2) Plan Set conceptual plans with sufficient detail to review the scope, costs, and impacts; submissions with engineered plans will be more competitive
- 3) Project Cost Estimate use the Sample Cost Estimating Table from CTDOT

SCCOG provide subsurface investigations in accordance with the LOTCIP Pavement Evaluation Checklist (see CTDOT website) for projects that are required to provide this information during the Phase II process. SCCOG and their consultant will provide the subsurface data to the municipality for review/analysis and inclusion into the LOTCIP application in accordance with the CTDOT LOTCIP requirements. Services will be on a first come, first served basis until available funds are exhausted. The municipalities that identify the need for subsurface investigation should request services from SCCOG at their earliest convenience, but no later than January 17, 2025 to ensure that the investigation program can be completed, and data incorporated into the LOTCIP application.

SCCOG Solicitation Role

COGs are tasked with reviewing, prioritizing and endorsing municipal applications. SCCOG solicits projects from municipalities and ensures eligibility, purpose and need, and completeness prior to endorsement. Final full applications are due to SCCOG by June 6, 2025. Projects not advanced under LOTCIP funding may be eligible for other funding. CTDOT will rank all applications received statewide.

SCCOG Application Review and Selection

Municipalities with Phase I pre-applications that have been selected to move forward with a full application will be notified at the SCCOG meeting on **April 16, 2025**.

Municipalities can then submit Phase II full applications for review through June 6, 2025. Municipalities should submit the Phase II applications as promptly as possible as full applications will be reviewed in the order that they are received. SCCOG may provide comments on applications for incorporation prior to advancing the full application to the board for endorsement.

All Phase II full applications must be **provided by June 6, 2025**. Once applications are endorsed by SCCOG they will be sent to CTDOT for funding review.
