In the submission requirements, SCCOG has requested that we submit the following document. The Department provides on their website proof of a current Affirmative Action Plan approved by CTDOT. Can we simply provide proof of an approved plan to meet this requirement?

Conflict of Interests:

If successful, would the selected consultant be excluded from being able to pursue municipal design services associated with the various funding sources (LOTICIP, CMAQ, STP, etc)?

- SCCOG anticipates hiring one (1) firm. A conflict of interests exists only for the LOTICIP program where the chosen SCCOG consultant directly reviews design plans and applications contracted by municipalities. In the instance of the consultant drafting plans for a municipality, they would not be permitted to review their own work.
